FUNDSCRIP


Each month, we will place an order on the first Sunday, so today is the day! When you buy FundScrip gift cards you don't pay any extra and a percentage comes back to the church. You can buy cards as gifts, or you can use them for your regular purchases of groceries, gas, restaurant meals, clothing, etc. It's a great way to help the church when you're buying things that you would buy anyway! Visit the FundScrip table in the gym following worship to place your order. We will order again on Nov. 3 and Dec. 1.

You can place your own order with FundScrip and have it mailed to your home address, as often as you want. There is no charge for the postage.

- 1. Go to the FundScrip website: fundscrip.com
- Create your own account. Be sure to enter the Invitation code for First Church - 86MLRU
 That way, First Church will get credit for your purchases.
- 3. Shop for the cards you wish to purchase. You need to order between \$200 and \$400, with no more than 4 cards.
- 4. When you go to Checkout it will show that First Presbyterian Church is the beneficiary. **Be Sure** to edit the Shipping (or your cards will be shipped to First Church!) Click on Edit and choose Direct Shipping. Then enter your home address. Select Lettermail from the options.
- 5. Choose a payment method. The easiest and best is EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer) where it will be transferred directly from your bank, like paying with debit! Click on the link to set up your EFT. It's easy to do just log in to your own bank account. (You may have to click on Shop then back to Checkout for it to be an available choice).
- Click on Checkout and you will have a chance to review your order, then click on Place Order. It will show you how much the church will receive for your order.

GROW HOPE SASKATCHEWAN



The 2024 crop year is drawing to a close. The Synod of Saskatchewan has received enough donations to sponsor over 19 acres of crop. Donations are used to pay for fuel, seed and fertilizer. Out of 428 donated acres, about 310 have been sponsored so far. Proceeds from the sale of crops may be matched up to 4 times by Global Affairs Canada. So this project is a wonderful way to help the hunger crisis in our world. Our proceeds go to the Canadian FoodGrains Bank where they are used to fund PWS&D projects that battle world hunger.
